

Frequently Asked Questions

CAPTAINS

How do I enter the scores of a match? My Activities > Select Division > Find the Match You Want to Enter > Submit Scores

How do I enter a default? To enter a default for 1 or 2 courts, enter the player names of the team who did NOT default, leave the opposing team players who are defaulting blank. Do NOT enter scores. Go to: Additional Details > Retire/Withdraw/Walkover/Default > Select: Yes – Default > Specify the Winner > Winner Doubles Pair A or B

How do I enter a retire? To enter a retire for 1 or 2 courts, enter the player names. Enter the scores of the games that were completed. Do NOT enter scores of incomplete games or games not played. Go to: Additional Details > Retire/Withdraw/Walkover/Default > Select: Yes – Retire > Specify the Winner > Winner Doubles Pair A or B

Do I play a 3rd set or a 10-point tiebreaker? In the Summer & Fall divisions you play a 10-point tiebreak in place of a 3rd set. In the Winter division you play best of 3 sets or to time, whichever comes first.

How do I enter the score for a 10-point tiebreak? You must enter 1-0 as the score for the 10-point tiebreak. After you do this, two small yellow boxes will automatically populate and there you can enter the score of the tiebreak (i.e. 10-8). If you accidentally played a third set, the score must be entered as 1-0 - you cannot enter the games in the third set box.

How are the standings calculated? Summer & Fall: Standings are calculated based on a point system. You earn 1 point for every game won and 6 points for every set won. Winter: Standings are calculated based on the percentage of games won.

SCORING

I averaged our points and it does not equal the total displayed for the standings. Make sure you have averaged all matches played. If you have

played the same team more than once, the match points or percentages are added up and divided by the number of times you have played that time and it counts as 1 match in the standings calculations.

I played the same team twice in my division, how do you average those matches? If you play the same team, more than once in a season, those points (Summer & Fall) or percentages (Winter) are added up and divided by the number of times you have played that team and only count as 1 match.

What determines if you win a match in the Summer & Fall League?

Summer & Fall scoring is based on a point system. 1 point for every game won. 6 points for every set won. 3rd set tiebreaker counts as 7 points - 1 point for the game and 6 points for the set.

What determines if you win a match in the Winter League? The Winter League is based on the number of games won. You play until time is up (no 3rd set tiebreak) and the team that wins the most games is the winner of the match.

How are division standings calculated? Division standings are and average calculated by adding the number of points earned (Summer & Fall) or the percentage of games won (Winter) and dividing by the number of matches played.

PLAYOFFS

When are semifinals? Semifinals are played the week following the last season match, on your regular division day. In the event that day falls on a holiday, the match will be played the following week.

Who advances to the finals? In divisions with 6 or more teams, the winners of the semifinal matches advance to the finals. In divisions with less than 6 teams, the top 2 teams advance to the finals.

How do I know if my team will play in the playoffs? You will receive an email from the League once all regular season matches have been entered and confirmed. You will receive an additional email from the League if your team advances to the Finals.

Who can play in the playoffs? Eligible players for the playoffs have to have played in at least 2 matches (Summer & Fall) or 1 match (Winter) on your team during the regular season. If they were added to your team midseason as a sub, from another team in the same division, that player can only play for their "home" team for playoffs.

My team made it to the playoffs, who do we play? For divisions of 6 or more teams, the number 1 team will host the number 4 team and the number 2 team will host the number 3 team. The winners of those two duels will advance to the finals. All semifinal matches are scheduled by the team captains. It is the captains responsibility to schedule the courts with their club and coordinate with the opposing team captain.

REGISTRATION

Do all players need to register for the upcoming League? No, only captains need to register their team.

I have more than one team, can I register them all at once? No, you cannot register your teams all at once. You need to go through the registration process for each team.

When will my registration be approved? The League will work to process teams within 1-3 business days and you will receive a confirmation email from the League when your registration has been approved.
